2. As for point 6, extra classes were conducted for meritorious as well as weak students. Also, the SOP regarding the pandemic was fully complied during off-line exams.
3. As for point 7, a total of 14 teachers to write and publish more research papers and books to their credit.
4. As for point 8, the college organized 4 webinars and one workshop.
5. As for the point 9, the college organized 03 FDPs and 07 capacity building programs including online programs also.
6. As for point 10, four such life skills programs were organised in the college for the students.
7. As for point 11 the college organised on-line 04 state level, 02 national level competitions and 05 District level cultural programs.

9. As for point 13 college is speeding up the activities undertaken under the RUSA projects.
10. As for point 14, the college has been celebrating Days of national importance for example International Yoga day, World Environment day etc.
11. As for point 15, Alumni meet was organized on 13.03.2021 and around 80 members were present.
12. As for point 16, after the encouragement by the college 09 teachers completed the refresher courses in SWAYAM/NPTEL
13. As for point 17, 02 spiritual values related programs were organised.
14. As for point 18, Yoga classes were held on the college premises.
15. As for point 19, 04 such lectures/programs were held by the college.
16. According to suggestions provided by Sh. Arun Bhagat:
 - (i) Already some facilities are provided and more will be provided in future for Divyangjans
 - (ii) More capacity of solar energy will be created in the college and it will be planned under RUSA Grant.
 - (iii) One vaccination camp was organized on of 13th April 2021 for the staff and students in the college and also for the neighborhood citizens. The college is committed towards such service of community in future also.

- (iii) The college has adequately improved facilities in the canteen and parking area.
