Minutes of the (Second) Quarterly Meeting of the College IQAC for the session 2018-19 held on 25-2-2019

The Quarterly Meeting of the College IQAC for the session 2018-19 was held in the College IQAC Room at 2:30 p.m. on 25-2-2019 with the Principal in the Chair. First of all, a two minute silence was observed in the memory of the victims of the Pulwama terror attack.

The following business was transacted in the meeting:

The Agenda of the meeting was read out. In pursuance of the agenda,

1(a)	The minutes of the Opening Meeting of the College IQAC for the session 2018-19 were confirmed.
1(b)	The Action Taken Report, in the respect of the Plan of Action announced and discussed in the Opening Meeting as well as the suggestions made therein, was ratified and approved.
2	The House was assured that a Shooting Range with the latest technology and infrastructure would soon be set up in the college.
3	As for infrastructure upgradation, the House was informed that the work in that regard was very much on. Wall tiling has been completed in the BBA and BCA Block, the outer wall of the PG Block has been re-plastered and concrete steps have been taken for IT procurement and upgradation.
4	As for setting up more smart class rooms, the House was informed that the two more such class rooms had been added during the current session and more were in the pipeline.
5	As for replacing conventional tube rods with eco-friendly LED tube lights as well as CFL bulbs with LED bulbs in the college campus, the House was told that the process was very much on.
6	As for organizing lectures on Intellectual Property Rights, it was placed on record that one such lecture had already been organized in the current session and there were plans to organize more such lectures in the ongoing academic session.
7	As for organizing a workshop on dietetics to circumvent the junk food crisis, the House was informed that one such workshop would be organized in March, 2019.
8	As for providing ICT related training and re-training to the students and the faculty, it was placed on record that some such programmes had already been organized during the current session and more such training programme would be organized on a continuous basis.
9	A number of suggestions geared towards quality assurance were made by the members with the permission of the Chair. All those suggestions were duly noted to be acted upon to the extent possible.

The meeting came to an end with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
