- Student Welfare:** A vital component, this segment of the survey evaluated various support systems provided by the institution. Aspects like counselling services, health facilities, extracurricular opportunities, and inclusivity initiatives were probed to gauge their influence on student well-being.

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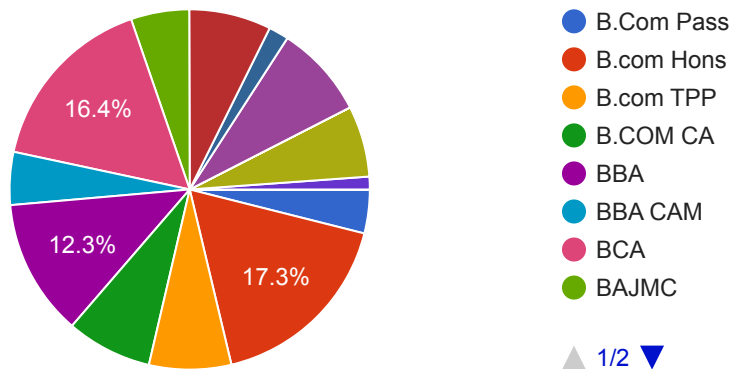

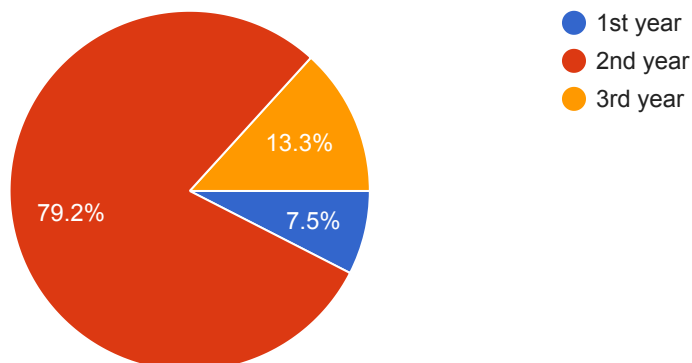

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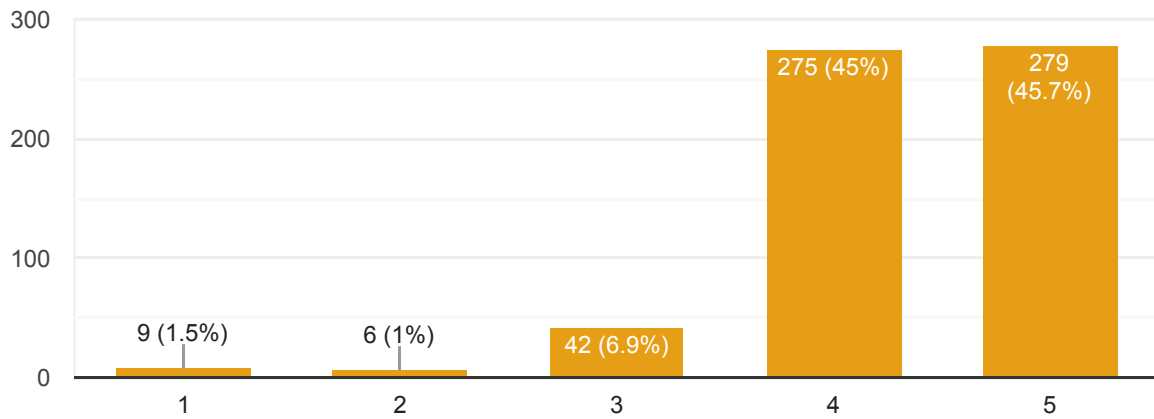

1. How much of the class content matched the curriculum?



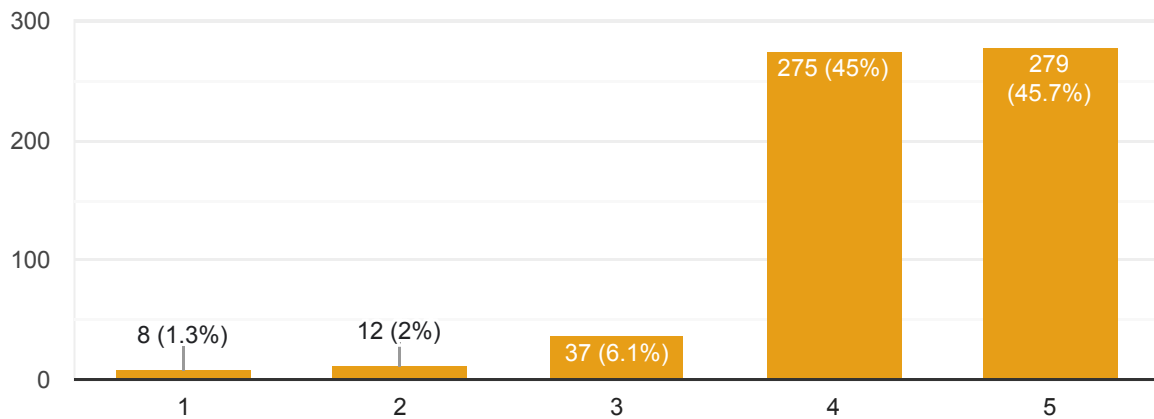
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2. How adequately were the teachers prepared for the lessons?



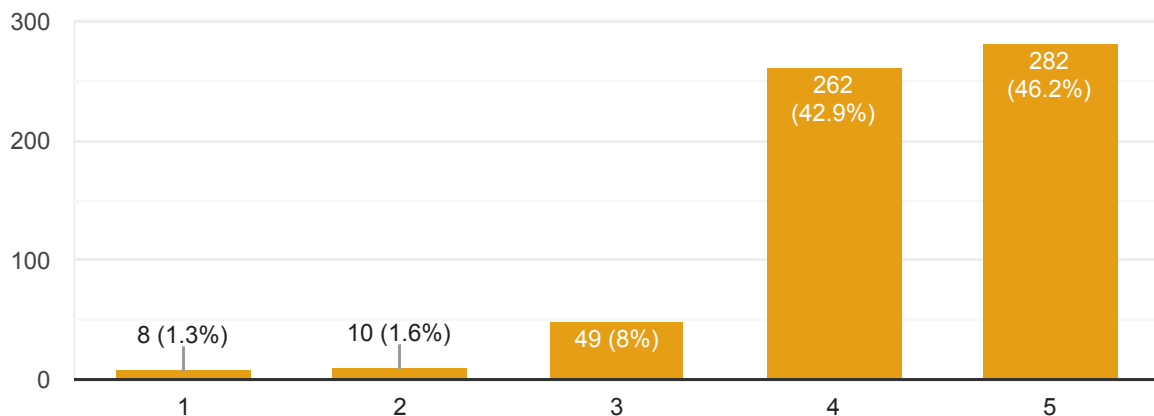
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3. Rate your level of satisfaction with the teachers' ability to communicate:



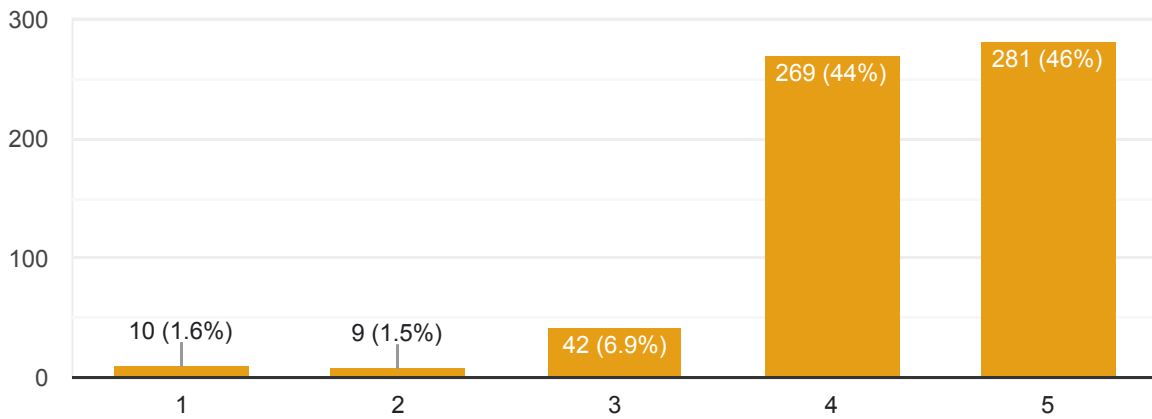
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4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as



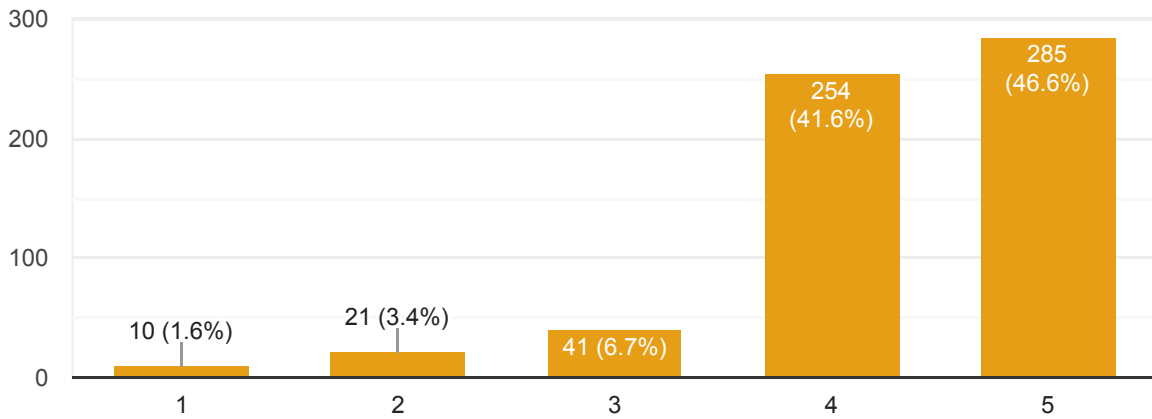
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5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.



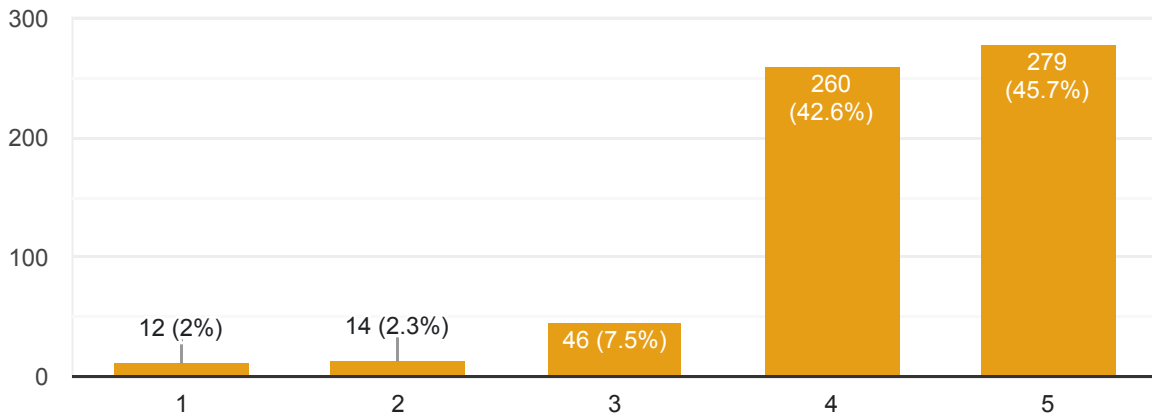
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6. Whether your performance in assignments was discussed with you:



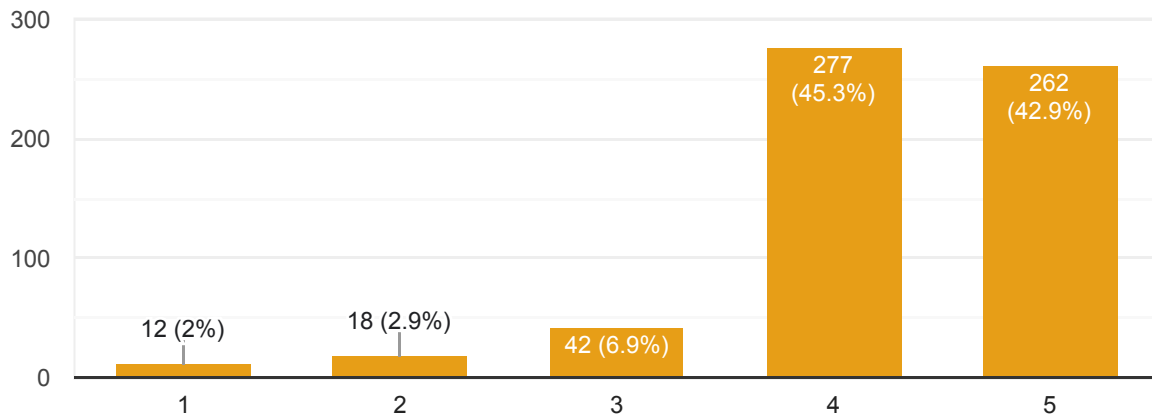

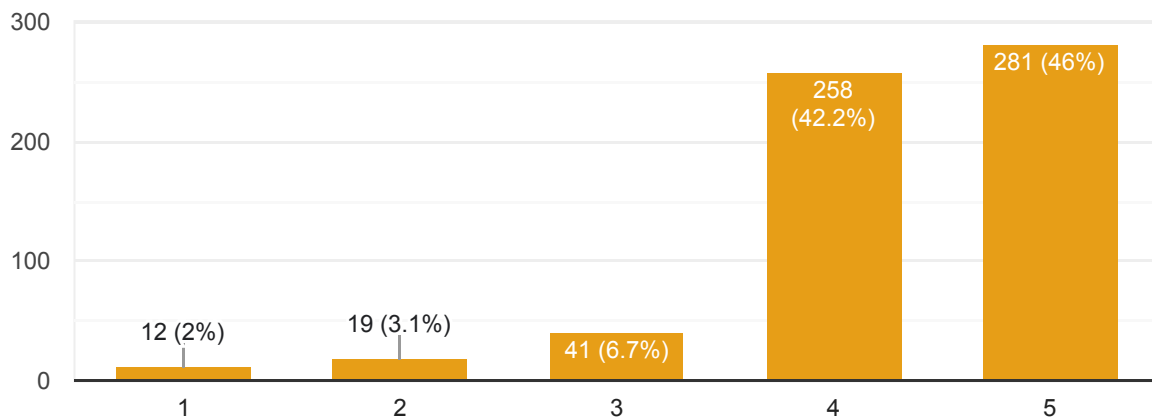
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8. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.



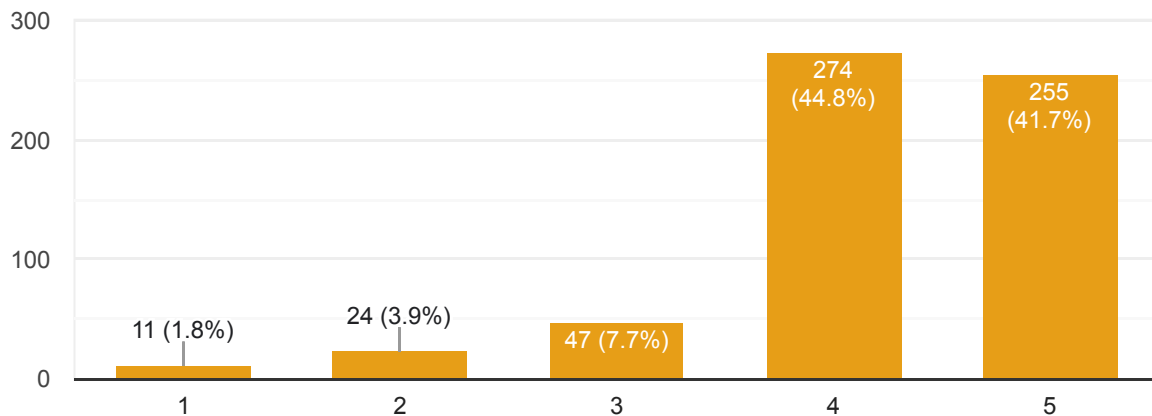
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9. The college takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange , field visit opportunities for students.



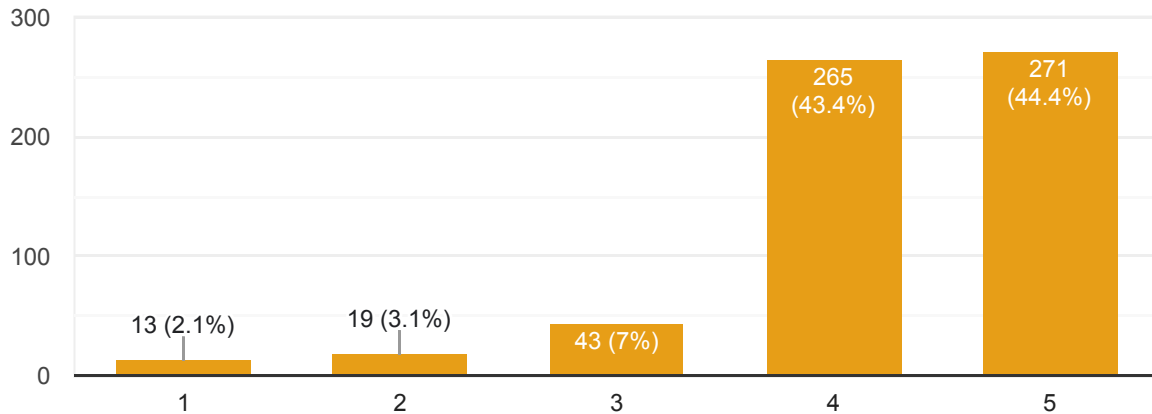
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10. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.



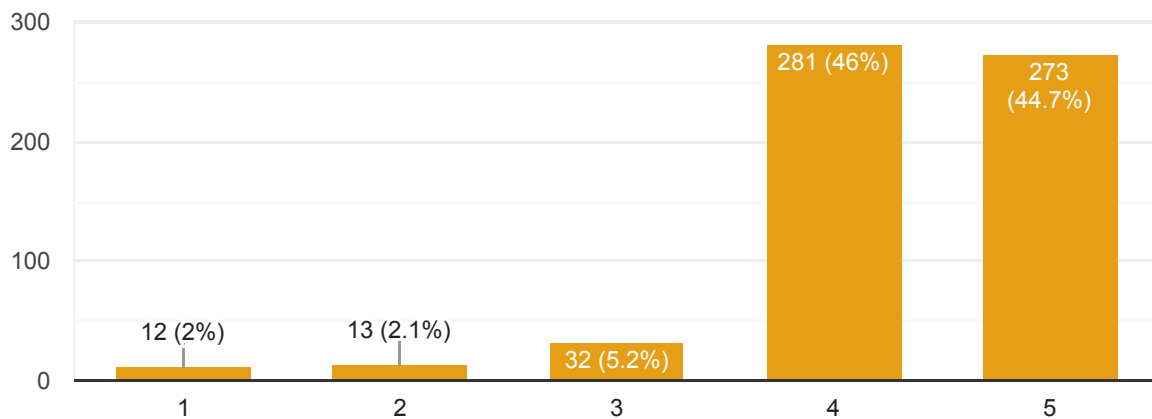
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11. The college provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow



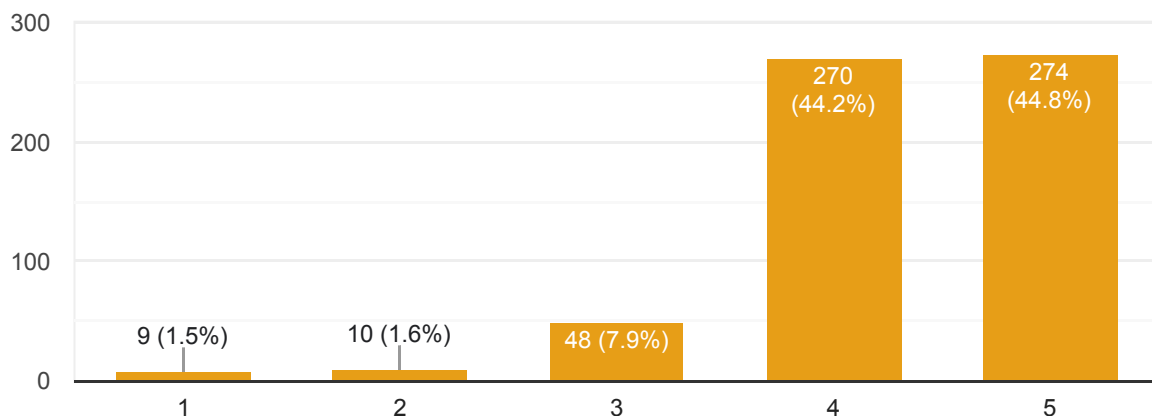
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12. The college makes effort to engage students in activities for quality improvement of the teaching learning process.



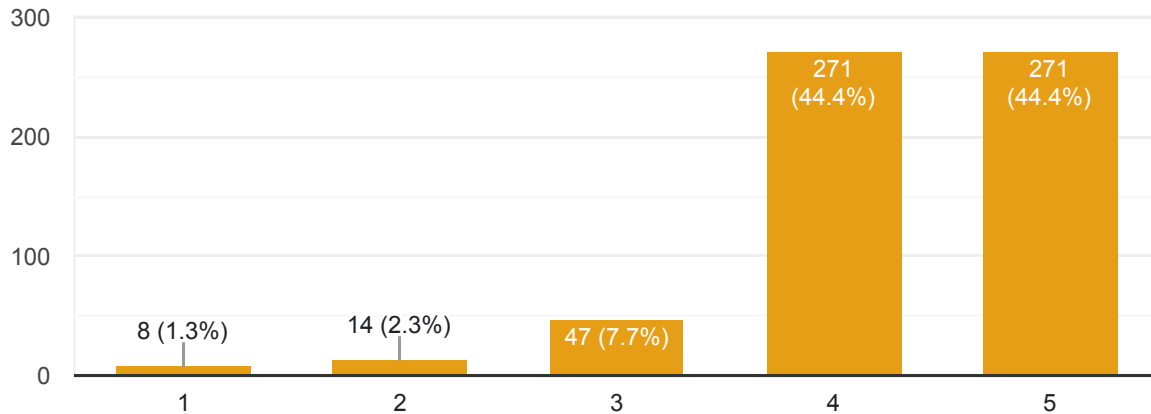
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13. Efforts are made by the college/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.



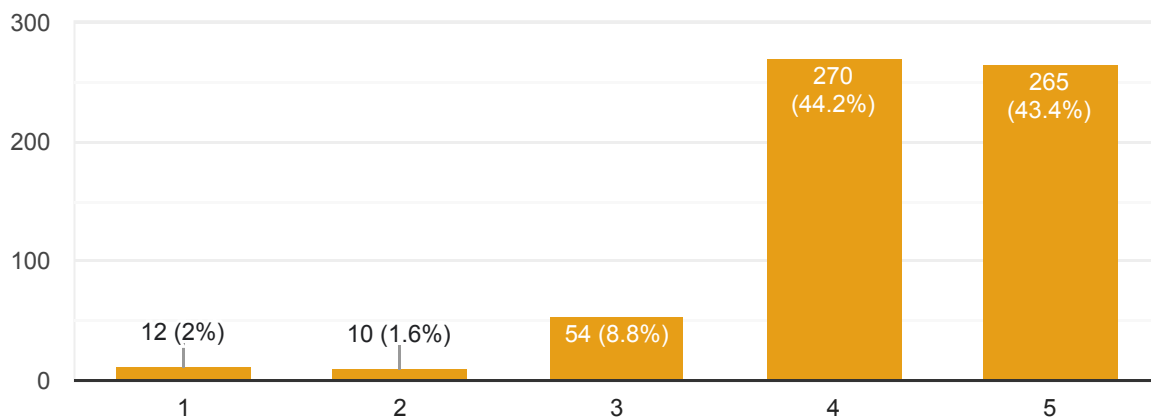
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14. The college/teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.



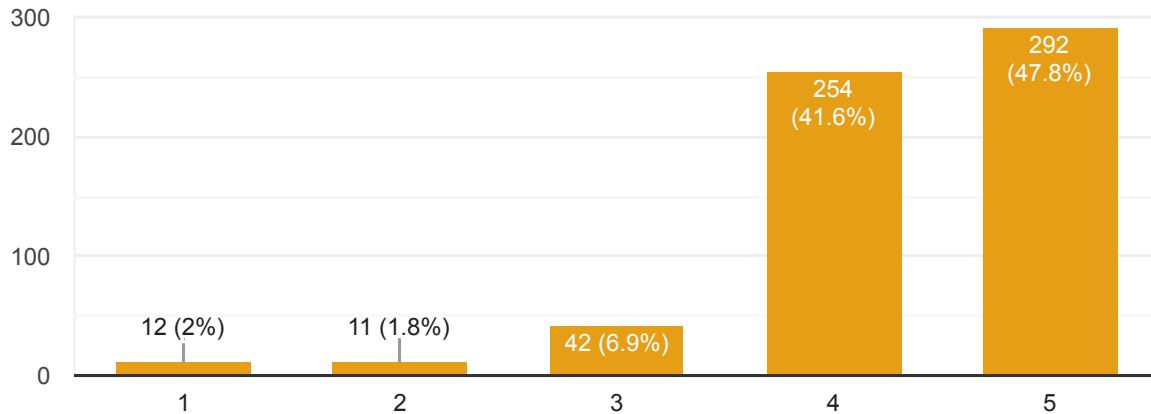
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15. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcome



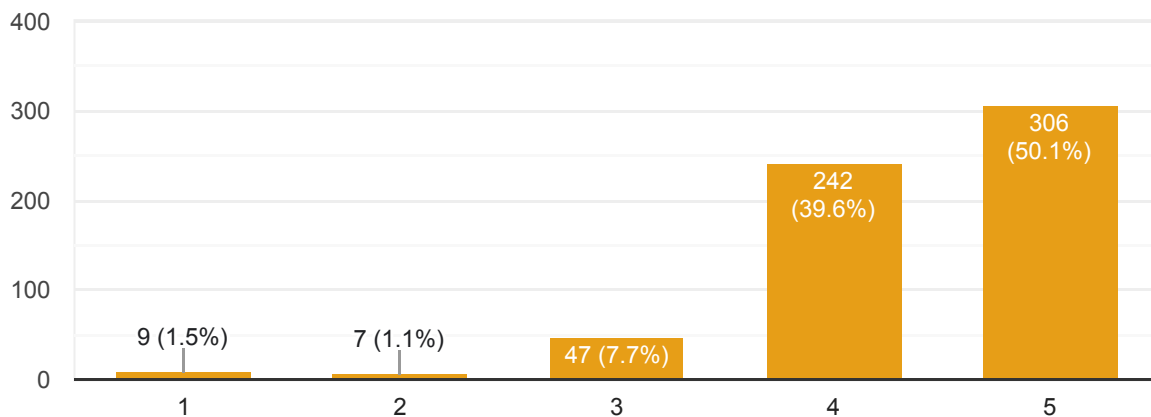
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16. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications



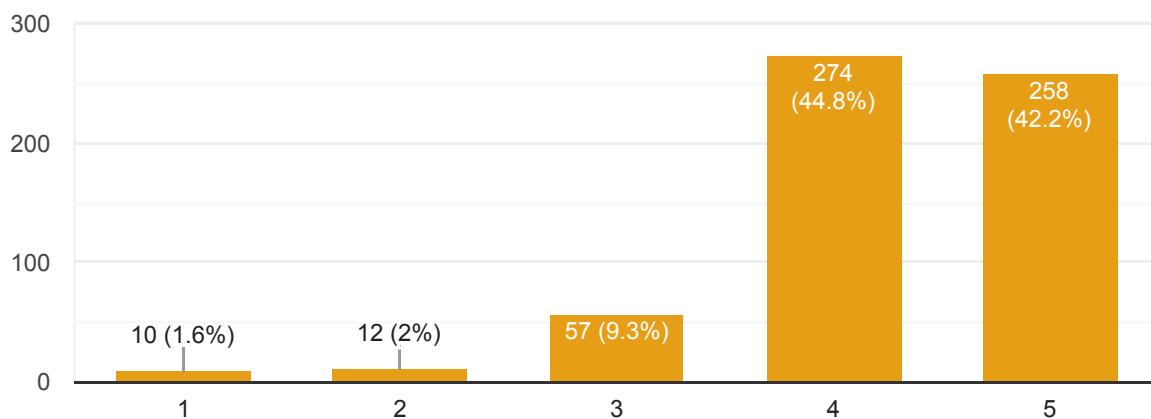
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17. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.



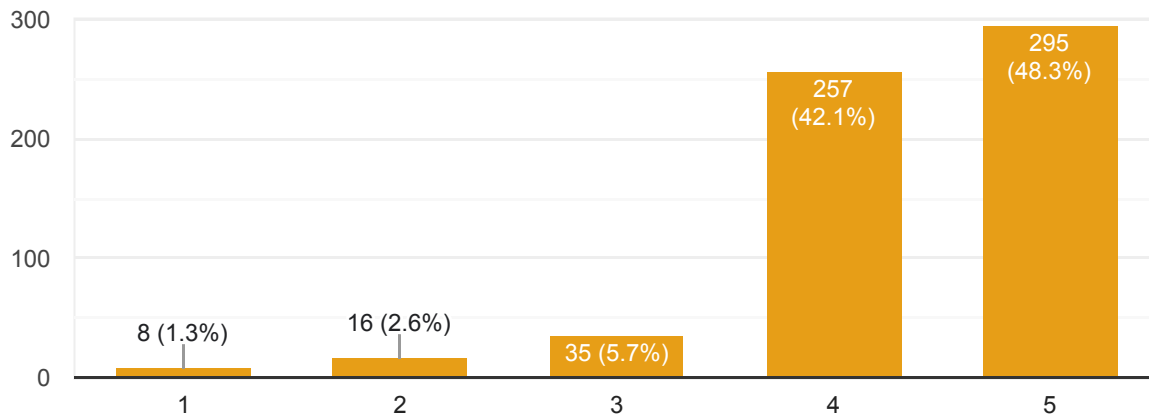
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18. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.



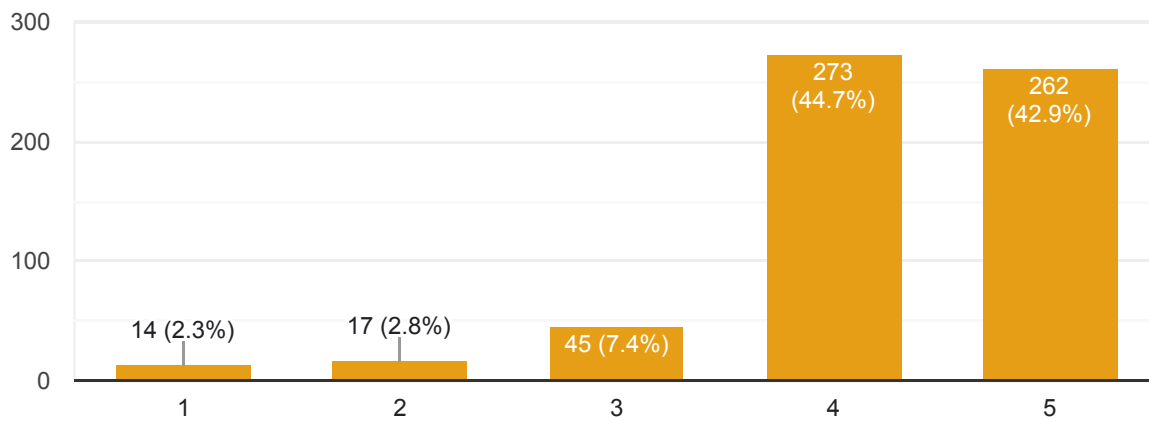
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19. The percentage of teachers who use ICT tools such as LCD projectors, multimedia, etc. during teaching:
