STUDENT FEEDBACK ACTION TAKEN REPORT (2019-2020)

- Two National Webinars on Tourism management and Mass Communication were conducted by the BTTM Department of the college & BAJMC Department of the College to enhance the students understanding about the subject.
- The internet speed in the college is going to raise to 50 MBPS so that online teaching and Learning during pandemic will be conducted without any interruption.
- Students' Council in the affairs of the college in order to increase the involvement of students, two members of the above Council have been inducted into the College IQAC.
- In lieu of infrastructure, the underground water storage tank of 1 lakh liter capacity is about to complete and will shortly be ready for use. The floor level of the Canteen Wing has already been raised and the work of floor tiling has also been completed. The work on creating the water harvesting facility as an alternative source in the college, the work is in progress. The renovation of the classrooms in the Arts and Commerce Wings of the

- NAAC was duly approached for approval for holding a National Conference on an important aspect related to institutional quality maintenance.
- EMA organizes various events at the college level during this year. These include a Talent Search Competition, Teej Festival celebrations including Mehndi, Dance & Singing Competitions for girl students, and Janamashtmi celebrations in which both students and teachers participated. A State Level Quiz was organized by all the PG Departments together, Poster Making events, National level PPT competitions organized by the departments and the Hindi & Sanskrit Week is also celebrated for the students. As for sports, Pistol and Rifle Shooting Competitions and a 15-day Yoga Camp for students at the college level have been organized during this session.
- The matter of starting the B. Voc. Course in Retail Management is being taken up with the management for their necessary approval so that the college can start the above Course from the next academic session.
- To keep in mind, the smooth conducting of Classes during lockdown in COVID-19 pandemic, Classes were started for the students as per the DGHE guidelines as two days' offline mode and four days in online mode per week.
